Holy Trinity Church West Hendred -Heating

We're making much needed improvements to the church's heating. The plan is to install under-pew heaters similar to those at Denchworth Church, and also Childrey Church. Based on the experience of other similar churches, these heaters will not only be more effective at keeping the congregation warm but also cost considerably less to run.

Electric Heating Solutions (EHS), who specialise in church heating and have installed under-pew heaters in several churches in Oxfordshire, have quoted £12,900 net – the church can claim back most of the VAT.

The Parochial Church Council has decided the heating is the priority works to the building, following the completion of the urgent work to the North Aisle roof. We submitted the works approval application (faculty) for Oxford Diocese's approval as soon as we had received all the documents from EHS that the Diocese need. Our caseworker at the Diocese has said "Church Buildings team will review it and then send our advice on to the Archdeacon." Hopefully it won't take long to get the Diocese's approval, which we need not just for the work itself, but also for grant applications.

Oxfordshire Historic Churches Trust (OHCT) have indicated they may be able to help towards the cost and mentioned "So pleased you are progressing with your heating and that you will be applying for a grant from us. The next awards meeting is in February."

This should improve managing the heating, which is the Hall's biggest running cost. THANK YOU for the generous contribution of £1,000 from the Beer Festival's outstanding funds – this has really helped towards our running costs in 2023.
